1. PAYMENT OF UMPIRES FOR SERVICES RENDERED TO CLUB CRICKET

No payments will be made for the following services: -

1. Umpiring in friendly matches.
2. Umpiring in friendly Inter Club Tournaments.
3. Instructor for any umpiring course.
4. Umpiring in league matches played under the auspices of the Eastern Schools Cricket Association and Eastern Junior Club Cricket Association, unless such umpiring is part of the ECUA development policy and such a policy is approved prior to the season commencing.
5. Umpires, who do not follow the playing regulations, whether deliberately or through ignorance. Such umpires shall be subject to an ECUA Disciplinary hearing and will lose their total match fee.

Payments will be made for the following services: -

1. Payment will only be made for a maximum of 2 umpires per league match.
2. Payment will be made for expenses incurred should an Executive of ECUA be requested to attend a meeting outside the geographical area of the East Rand region for and on behalf of the Club Cricket Committee.
3. 3rd man duties at night fixtures provided the performance of such duties is part of the Eastern Cricket Umpires Associations development program.
4. Specific requests for umpiring services made by the Director – Club Cricket & Facilities.

2. PAYMENT OF SCORERS FOR SERVICES RENDERED TO CLUB CRICKET

No payments will be made for the following services: -

1. Scoring in friendly matches.
2. Scoring in friendly Inter Club Tournaments.
3. Scoring in any other leagues other than Premier unless such scoring is part of the ECSA development policy. The Club Cricket Committee must approve such a policy prior to the season commencing.
4. Instructor for any scoring course.
5. Scoring in matches played under the auspices of the Eastern Schools Cricket Association and Eastern Junior Club Cricket Association unless such scoring is part of the ECSA development policy. The Club Cricket Committee must approve such a policy prior to the season commencing.
6. Scorers who do not follow the playing regulations, whether deliberately or through ignorance. Such scorers shall be subject to an ECSA Disciplinary hearing and will lose their total match fee.

Payments will be made for the following services: -

1. Payment will only be made for a maximum of 1 scorer per Premier league match unless an additional scorer is part of the ECSA development policy. The Club Cricket Committee must approve such a policy prior to the season commencing.
2. Specific requests for scoring services made by the Executive Director - Club Cricket & Facilities.

3. AFFILIATION REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW CLUBS

Clubs originating from the Junior Club Cricket Association: -

1. Application must be made in writing.
2. Club must submit their constitution and any other documentation that may be required for approval. A minimum of one team may be entered into the league. The team will commence in the lowest league.
3. The club must have played for a minimum of one season in Senior League Competition before seeking affiliation.

New clubs originating from outside the Junior Club Cricket Association: -

1. Application must be made in writing.
2. Club must submit their constitution and any other documentation that may be required for approval. A minimum of two teams must be entered into the league.
3. The teams will commence in the lowest two leagues.
4. The club must provide their own home field of the required standard.
5. The club is restricted from granting membership to any person registered with another club for a period of one year.
6. The club will not benefit from any financial grant until they have completed one full season.

4. APPLICATION OF THE POLICIES

The Policies will be applicable to all Members of Eastern Cricket. In addition the policies shall be applicable to affiliates of Associations.

Eastern Cricket **instructs** all chairpersons, secretaries and committee members of Associations and Clubs to **study** the policies and to acquaint themselves with the contents thereof.

A lack of knowledge of these policies will **not** absolve any person, Club or Association of any liability, responsibility or consequence.
